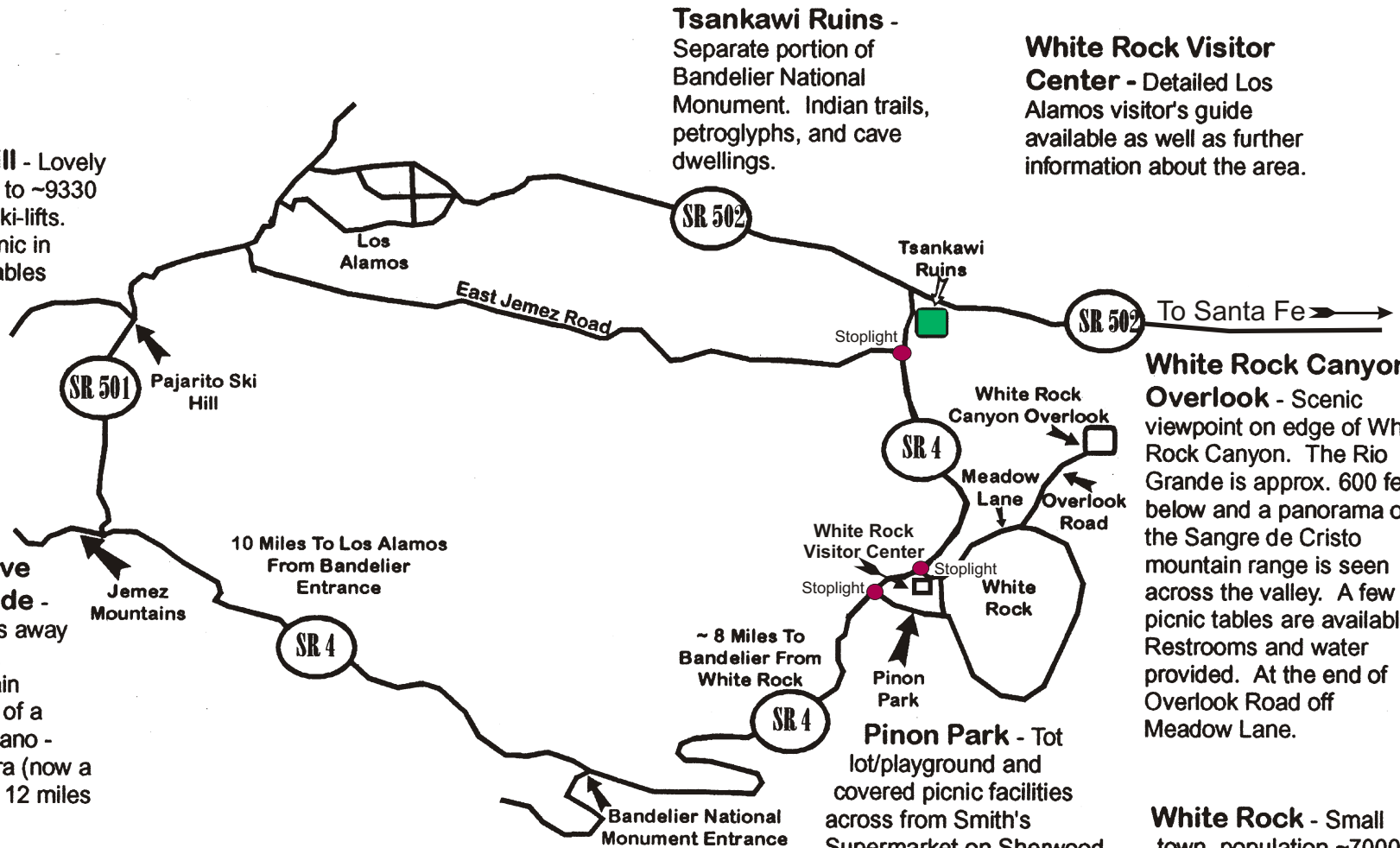


LOS ALAMOS, WHITE ROCK VICINITY

Pajarito Ski Hill - Lovely mountain drive up to ~9330 feet at bottom of ski-lifts. Great place to picnic in summer. Picnic tables are located beyond the ski hill.

Jemez Mountain Drive to Valle Grande - About 30 minutes away on State Road 4. Beautiful mountain drive with a view of a large extinct volcano - the Valles Caldera (now a meadow approx. 12 miles in diameter).



Tsankawi Ruins - Separate portion of Bandelier National Monument. Indian trails, petroglyphs, and cave dwellings.

White Rock Visitor Center - Detailed Los Alamos visitor's guide available as well as further information about the area.

White Rock Canyon Overlook - Scenic viewpoint on edge of White Rock Canyon. The Rio Grande is approx. 600 feet below and a panorama of the Sangre de Cristo mountain range is seen across the valley. A few picnic tables are available. Restrooms and water provided. At the end of Overlook Road off Meadow Lane.

Pinon Park - Tot lot/playground and covered picnic facilities across from Smith's Supermarket on Sherwood Boulevard. Restroom, water available.

White Rock - Small town, population ~7000, with amenities including Smith's grocery store, gas stations, fast food, lodging, and post office.
