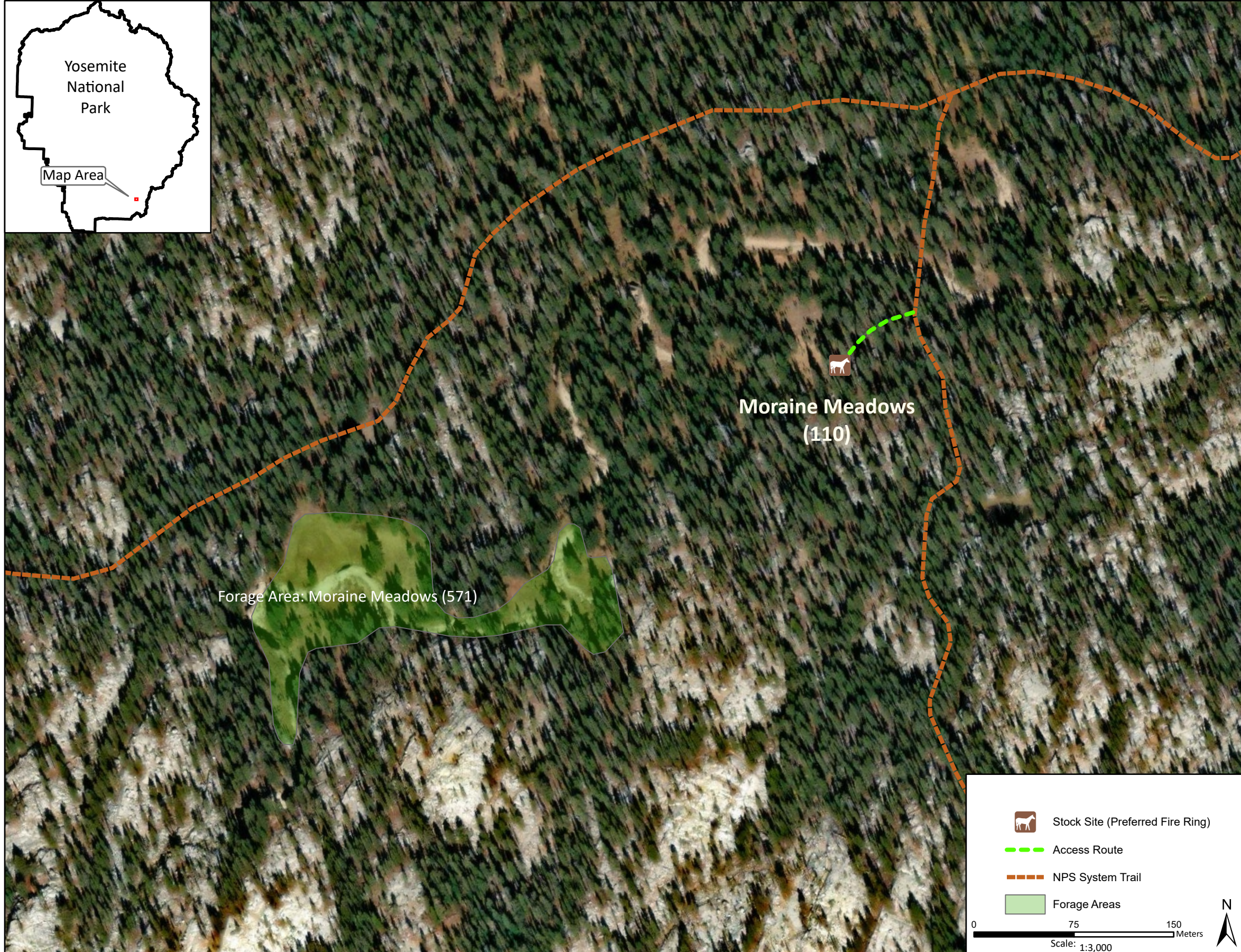
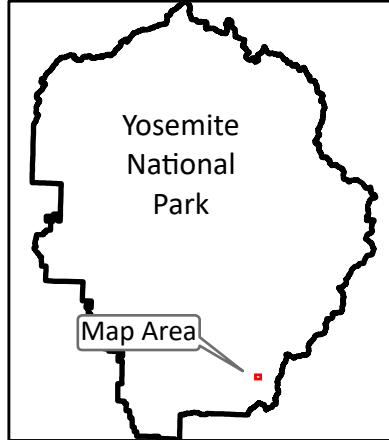


Stock Site Evaluation Project Moraine Meadows

Forage Area: Moraine Meadows (571) - There are multiple small meadow areas north and south of the South Fork of the Merced River that compose the Moraine Meadows complex. There is limited understory forage surrounding the meadows.

Annual Grazing Capacity: 20 stock use nights

Moraine Meadows

Camp ID: 110

Fire Ring: 286,096mE x 4,163,799mN

Handling Practices: This site is located in Moraine Meadows south of the South Fork of the Merced River and west of the NPS system trail. The access route begins approximately 40 m south of the river and heads southwest approximately 70 m to the fire ring. The unloading area and holding area are at the fire ring.
