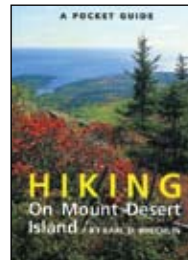

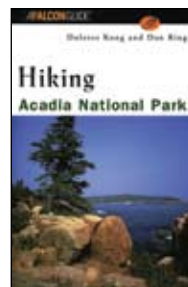

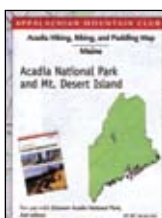

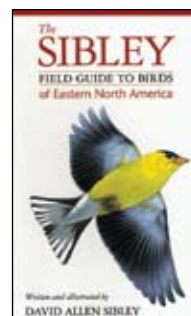

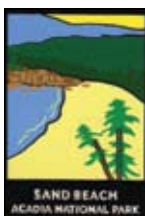

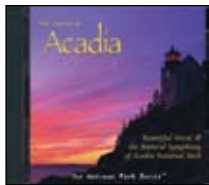

Alan Nyiri has created a visually stunning look at Acadia National Park

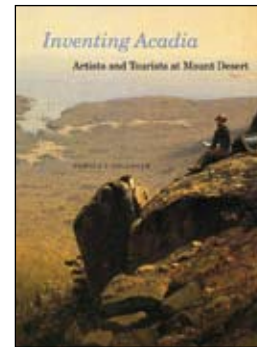
