

Harry Bailey: When the so-called task force would come in, because they would go down to Paramushiro, in the Kurile Islands, they'd bombard them and they always came in at night. When you woke up in the morning you'd see that. There was probably two cruisers. This wasn't much of a so-called task force, it was very small compared to the south Pacific but they – two cruisers and probably six or seven destroyers. And when they would come in they had to be, I don't know if they stocked up on food and so forth, and we were designated to do that one time.
