- ◻ **April 4 Songbirds Sing Again: Rehabilitating small bird species of Alaska**
Leah Connor will discuss her years of experience rehabilitating and successfully releasing hummingbirds, robins, thrushes and other bird species back into the wild.

- ◻ **April 11 Breeding Birds of the Ketchikan**
Andy Piston will give an overview of the Ketchikan breeding bird season and bird breeding biology. All images in the program will be of locally photographed birds and nests!

- ◻ **April 18 Live Bird Presentation**
