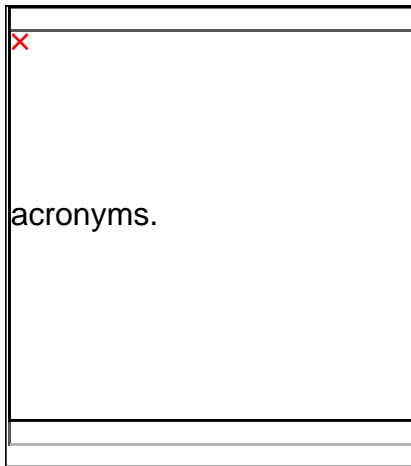


# Acronym Web Quest for the Curious
