The Special Use Permit program provides for agricultural use and/or livestock grazing on certain parcels of land within Buffalo National River. Agriculture plays a very important role in managing the landscape of Buffalo National River. Without farming, the fields would quickly turn into forest. Farmed fields are part of the cultural landscape and provide a wide variety of habitat for a number of species.

Agricultural Special Use Permits within Buffalo National River are issued through a competitive selection process. A request for solicitation to bid on specific parcels will be announced via press releases and government websites. Park contact information:
