2nd Annual San Diego Parks and Open Spaces Day at Cabrillo National Monument

[Point Loma, San Diego, California] Superintendent Tom Workman invited everyone to visit Cabrillo National Monument on Saturday, July 24, as part of the 2nd Annual San Diego Parks and Open Spaces Day. Come and enjoy the summertime at Cabrillo National Monument, *San Diego's National Park*, and learn about the many other parks, natural areas, and open spaces in the San Diego area. Said Workman, "This will surely be a wonderful event for all members of the San Diego community to enjoy the beautiful spaces that make San Diego such a delightful place to visit and live." Holders of an America the Beautiful Interagency Pass, America the Beautiful Senior Pass, America the Beautiful Access Pass, Golden Age Passport, Golden Access Passport or Cabrillo National Monument Annual Pass will be admitted free of charge upon presentation of their pass. Passes may be purchased at Cabrillo National Monument.
