WEDNESDAY, 7TH, 14TH, & 28TH -10:00 AM TO 12:00 PM-

“CANOE MOSQUITO LAGOON” Join a guide as you explore this rich and diverse estuary up close. Some experience is preferred. You must be at least 8 years old and able to paddle. You must wear covered shoes (no sandals or flip-flops). Bring water, sunscreen and a hat. Dress to get wet. Individuals with their own kayaks or canoes are welcome to join in. Reservations can be made a week in advance. Call (386) 428-3384 ext. 10 to reserve your spot. Meet at the pavilion at 9:45 a.m. we will leave promptly at 10:00 a.m.

FRIDAY, 9TH -10:00 AM-“BEACH WALK”

Join a park guide as you explore Apollo Beach. Discover the wonderful treasures which can be found if you just look. Hat, sunscreen and water recommended. Meet at the pavilion. (1 hour)

Learn the ancient art of pine needle basket weaving. It is great for beginners or those looking to brush up on their skills. The materials will be provided, just bring your imagination. Meet at the Eldora State House.

Learn how to collect this delicious bivalve from the waters of Mosquito Lagoon.
