**TUESDAY, 12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, & 26<sup>th</sup> -10:00 AM- “CANOE MOSQUITO LAGOON”**  
Reservations will begin a week before the canoe date. Join a guide as you explore this rich and diverse estuary up close. Some experience is preferred. You must be at least 8 years old and able to paddle. You must wear covered shoes (no sandals or flip-flops). Bring water, sunscreen and a hat. Dress to get wet. Individuals with their own kayaks or canoes are welcome to join in. Call (386) 428-3384 ext. 10 to reserve your spot. Meet at the Visitor Information Center at 9:45 a.m. we will leave promptly at 10:00 a.m.

**SATURDAY, 9<sup>TH</sup> 16<sup>TH</sup> & 23<sup>RD</sup> -10:00 AM- “BEACH TREASURE HUNT”** Walk the seashore with a ranger, for fun and exercise for about 1 mile. Bring sunscreen, hats and water. Meet at the visitor center. (1 hour)

**FRIDAY, 15<sup>TH</sup> - 10:00 AM –“CAST NET PROGRAM”** Learn the skill and grace that goes along with this fun hobby. If you have a cast net, feel free to bring it. We will provide a few. Bring water and insect repellent. Park at parking lot number one, and meet at the boat ramp. (1 hour)

**THURSDAY, 21<sup>ST</sup> -10:00 AM- “CLAMMING 101”** Learn how to collect this delicious bivalve from the waters of Mosquito Lagoon. Gathering clams has been an activity conducted in this area for thousands of years, learn tips, techniques and recipes along with the Florida bag and size limits. Must wear covered shoes (no sandals or flip flops). Park at parking lot number one, and meet at the boat ramp. (1 hour)

**SATURDAY, 30<sup>TH</sup>- 10:00 AM- “SEA TURTLE WRAP UP”** Join a Park Ranger as we discuss how Canaveral National Seashore’s 2010 sea turtle nesting season went. Meet at the visitor center. (1 hour)
