You will learn the history, both archaic and modern as it pertains to the significance of this site. This is an easy walk ending with a visit to the historic house. Meet at parking area. (45 minutes)

SUNDAY, JANUARY 17TH – 10:00AM AND 1:00 PM- “COAST TO COAST” Join a Ranger for a stroll from coast to coast. We’ll start on the banks of the lagoon and finish up on the shore of the Atlantic Ocean. Meet at the Eddy Creek dock, don’t forget sunscreen and water. (1 hour)
