SATURDAY, January 7th, & 14th – 10:00 AM “Fishing 101” Join a Ranger for a fun day of fishing. Learn about Mosquito Lagoon and why it is such a unique estuary. Meet at the Eddy Creek Dock; don't forget a hat, sunscreen and water. Limited amount of fishing rods. (1 hour)

SATURDAY, January 7th & 14th – 2:00 PM “Let's Talk Trash” Join a Ranger to talk about how everyday trash effects the beach, as well as the wildlife. Help the ranger pick up trash to keep the beach clean and beautiful. Meet at parking lot #1 (1 hour)

SUNDAY, January 8th, 15th, & 22nd – 1:00 PM- -“SEMINOLE REST WALK” Join a Ranger as you walk the trail at historic Seminole Rest and learn about the colorful history of this area. You will learn the history, both archaic and modern as it pertains to the significance of this site. This is an easy walk ending with a visit to the historic house. Meet at parking area. (45 minutes) **Directions:** Seminole Rest is located in the town of Oak Hill, Follow US 1 North to the city of Oak Hill and turn right on Halifax Road, Seminole Rest parking lot will be on your right hand side. US 1 South to the City of Oak Hill and turn left on Halifax road and the parking lot will be on your right hand side.
