SATURDAY, MARCH 13, 20 AND 27TH -1:00PM- “SEMINOLE REST WALK”
Join a Ranger as you walk the trail at historic Seminole Rest and learn about the colorful story of this area. You will learn the history, both archaic and modern as it pertains to the significance of this site. This is an easy walk ending with a visit to the historic house. Meet in the parking area. (45 minutes)

SUNDAY, MARCH 14, 21 AND 28TH -1:00PM- “COAST TO COAST” Take a stroll with a Ranger from coast to coast. We'll start on the banks of the lagoon and finish on the shore of the Atlantic Ocean. Meet at the Eddy Creek dock, don't forget sunscreen and water. (1 hour)
