

“AREA CLOSED” Signs

There are fenced areas with posted signs stating “Area Closed “and/or “Revegetation”. The majority of these signs are posted around the dune restoration areas, however, they may be in other areas of the park as well. These signs mean KEEP OUT. The dunes are fragile and the National Park Service strives to maintain or restore a healthy dune system. The dunes provide habitat and nesting areas for several threatened and endangered species including sea turtles and beach mice. Dunes also provide the first line of defense in protecting Mosquito Lagoon, park roads, NASA structures and the mainland from storm damage. There are fines associated with entry into dunes and closed areas.
