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HISTORY

Following the completion of a congressionally mandated study of the Cane River, Louisiana area in 1993, legislation was introduced in Congress and approved on November 2, 1994 (Public Law 103-499 [16USC410cc]) that created Cane River Creole National Historical Park (CARI) and the Cane River National Heritage Area (CRNHA). The legislation designated that the park would consist of lands on the Magnolia and Oakland Plantations.

Magnolia and Oakland Plantations are agricultural complexes located in Natchitoches Parish, Louisiana on Cane River, and Cane River Lake, respectively. The plantations were owned and continuously operated by the same French Creole families for seven generations, and include an extensive number of outbuildings, and retain the appearance and integrity of working family plantations. In recognition of their national significance in the areas of architecture and agriculture, both Oakland Plantation and Magnolia Plantation were granted National Bicentennial Farm status, and were designated as National Historic Landmarks, in 2000 and 2001, respectively.

The Oakland Plantation unit, which was owned by the Prud'homme family, consists of the entire remaining core plantation infrastructure of forty buildings, ranging from the main house and 1835 bottle garden, to numerous outbuildings spread over forty-four acres, including the plantation store, pigeonniers, a large seed house, workshops, and two slave quarters. The National Park Service purchased the land, buildings, and contents of Oakland Plantation from the Prud'homme family in 1997.

The Magnolia Plantation unit, which was owned by the LeComte-Hertzog family, is comprised of twenty-two outbuildings spread over nineteen acres, including a slave hospital, overseer's house, slave quarters complex, plantation store, blacksmith shop, and nineteenth-century cotton gin barn. These outbuildings, and the land they stand on, were donated by the Hertzog Family to Museum Contents, Inc. in 1982, and were later acquired by the National Park Service. The remaining core plantation infrastructure at Magnolia, including the main house, formal entrance, and immediate outbuildings, is privately owned and adjacent to the park.

CARI preserves the resources and cultural landscapes of the Cane River region and enhances the understanding of its peoples and traditions through research, interpretation, education, and technical assistance. It preserves the historic structures at Magnolia and Oakland Plantations, as well as the settings that help convey a sense of their historic character. The park authorizes archeological, oral history, and ethnographic projects to expand knowledge about Magnolia Plantation and Oakland Plantations, and maintains a facility to preserve artifacts associated with the plantations. CARI interprets the history of early European exploration and settlement of the Red River Valley in northwestern Louisiana during the early eighteenth-century; the resulting cultural interaction and interdependence among the French, Spanish, Africans, and Indians; and

the subsequent development and evolution of Creole culture and plantation life along the Cane River through the mid-twentieth-century, using public tours, ranger programs, publications, exhibits, and special events.

The CRNHA was established simultaneously with CARI, but is not part of the National Park Service, and instead is locally managed by community representatives appointed to the Heritage Area Commission. The heritage area was created to complement the park, and to provide a culturally sensitive approach to preserving the heritage of the Cane River region through local partnerships, thereby minimizing the need for federal land acquisition or management. It consists of mostly privately-owned lands along the Cane River systems, eight National Historic Landmark sites including the Natchitoches Historic District, and many other area resources.
