Fire Restrictions to be Implemented in Cedar Breaks National Monument; Campfires Prohibited

As a result of the high fire danger in Cedar Breaks National Monument restrictions are being instituted prohibiting campfires and smoking on trails. These restrictions will be in effect starting at **12:01 a.m. on Friday, July 13, 2007** and will be enforced until rescinded by the Superintendent. Park officials feel that the risk to public safety and structures within Cedar Breaks National Monument from a human-caused fire is great enough that these restrictions are necessary.

The following acts will be **prohibited** in Cedar Breaks National Monument until further notice starting **Friday, July 13, 2007 at 12:01 a.m.**

- **Setting, building, maintaining, attending, or using a campfire, including charcoal, in campgrounds, picnic areas, or permanently improved places of habitation.***
*Stoves fueled by petroleum and liquid Propane Gas (LPG) are allowed.
- **Smoking on all trails.***
*Smoking is allowed within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or designated smoking area.
- **Discharging, or using any kind of fireworks or other pyrotechnic devices, is prohibited at all times on all federal public lands.**

Violation of the above, prohibited acts is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 and/or imprisonment for not more than twelve months, or both.
