Cumberland Island National Seashore to Suspend Ferry Service due to Tropical Storm Fay

Cumberland Island National Seashore has implemented their park's Hurricane Plan according to the Incident Commander Chief Ranger Dennis Parsons. The park's boats are being pulled out of the water or located to a safer location. The park's landing craft is being relocated to Kings Bay Naval Submarine Base. The final ferry will run at 10:15am today to bring campers off the island. The vehicles and buildings are being secured and these preparations are targeted to be completed by 3pm today. The park will reopen at 9am on Saturday.
