## National Park Reopens Sections of the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail

**Brecksville, Ohio** – The National Park Service has reopened sections of the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail in Cuyahoga Valley National Park from Canal Visitor Center in Valley View to Boston Store Visitor Center in Peninsula, and then from Lock 29 Trailhead in Peninsula to Botzum Trailhead in Akron.

The following sections of the Towpath Trail remain closed due to flood damage:

- Lock 39 Trailhead to Canal Visitor Center
- Holzhauer Road Access & Parking Lot
- Boston Store Visitor Center to Lock 29 Trailhead
- Ira Road Trailhead Connector and Parking Lot
