Winter Film Festival “War Trains: Subvert and Destroy”

Effigy Mounds National Monument continues the 46th annual Winter Film Festival on Saturday, February 28th, with “War Trains: Subvert and Destroy”. Show times for the film are 10:00, 11:00 a.m., 12 noon, 1:00, 2:00, and 3:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday, February 28th and March 1st. There will also be a 1:00 p.m. showing on Monday, March 2nd.

“Subvert and Destroy” is the second in the War Trains series and shows how military trains have been used in sabotage through decades of warfare. Rail systems can be vitally important during times of combat, from shipping supplies through hostile areas to launching railway artillery. War Trains features the history of military railroads during the Civil War, World Wars I and II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War.

This year's festival again will feature art and displays in the Monument's visitor center. This week's display will feature the pottery of Jenna Haug of Decorah, Iowa.
