



El Morro and El Malpais Ranger-Guided Programs for June, 2008

Explore El Morro National Monument with a guided hike, daily in June.

Daily Hikes at El Morro Beginning Sunday, June 9, 10:00 a.m.–12:00 p.m.
Join us for a Ranger-led hike to the top of El Morro. This is a two mile, slightly strenuous hike. Bring water and wear good walking shoes. Meet at the El Morro Visitor Center. Guided hikes are free, but the \$3 per adult entrance fee applies.



Explore El Malpais National Monument with cave tours and bat flights, Saturdays in June.

Cave Tours of Junction Cave Saturday June 7 and Saturday June 21, 2:00 p.m.
Meet a Park Ranger at the parking lot of the El Calderon Area (21 miles south of Grants on NM 53) for a moderately strenuous caving adventure. Bring a flashlight, jacket, gloves, and water. Wear long pants and sturdy boots or tennis shoes. Helmets will be provided. Tours are limited to the first 20 people, so arrive early. This program is suitable for children 10 years and older.

Bat Flights at Bat Cave Saturday June 14 and Saturday June 28, 7:30 p.m.
Enjoy the company of thousands of bats as they leave Bat Cave for the evening. Meet a Park Ranger promptly at 7:30 in the parking lot of the El Calderon Area (21 miles south of Grants on NM 53). From there we will hike $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile to Bat Cave. Bring water, a jacket, and a flashlight for the hike back after dark.
