Narrative:

On June 6th, 2013 at approximately 1959 hrs Alaska Regional Communications Center (ARCC) received a report from Denali National Park and Preserve Visitor Center (DVC) staff that a visitor had shot a moose on a trail behind the visitor center. ARCC notified ranger staff. I, US Park Ranger Jeffrey Duckett responded to the DVC. While enroute ARCC told me the individual who shot the moose was at the visitor center and that he had shot the moose because it charged at him and the group he had been hiking with. Additionally it was indicated that the moose would have to dispatched due to its injuries. I arrived at the DVC at approximately 2004 and went to the scene, Supervisory ranger John Fish and NPS Special Agents (SA) Jack Carney and Steve Bell met with the individual who shot the moose. Ranger Liz Hamilton also responded.

I found the scene approximately 1/8 of a mile from the trailhead behind the DVC. I observed an adult female (cow) moose lying on its side on the east side of the trail. The moose was still alive and kicking its legs. I noted that there was a wound to the head and blood coming from the head. I observed the moose for a short period and noted that it was not able to get up and seemed beyond recovering. I took my agency issued 870 Remington Shotgun and dispatched the moose using two rounds to the head area.

Following this the individual who shot the moose arrived on scene. I identifed the individual as Robert Joseph SIRVID of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Eagle River, AK 99577

L SIRVID was visibly upset. I asked SIRVID to explain what happened. SIRVID provided the following statement: Prior to the incident he had been returning from a hike on the Triple Lakes Trail with four other people. He identified the four others as Mark, Rebecca, Isabella (age 7) and Anthony (age 5) Diorio of Makera, IL. SIRVID stated they were friends of his. At approximately 1950 as they rounded a comer on a trail they encountered a moose. SIRVID was unsure exactly how far away the moose was, but based on where SIRVID thought he was and where he thought the moose was, I determined that it was approximately 25 yards. The group stopped and first considered taking a picture but the moose immediately started walking towards them. The group began moving back the way they came but the moose charged. SIRVID stated he attempted to move behind a tree but the others began running back the way they came. SIRVID fearing that the moose might hurt the others, especially the children, drew the handgun he was carrying and fired one shot at close range into the moose's head. The moose fell down along the side of the trail. The group immediately went to the visitor center and reported the incident. SIRVID said he really did not want to shoot the moose but felt he had no choice.

SIRVID is a member of the US Air Force, stationed at Joint Base Elmendorf Richardson, near Anchorage, AK. SIRVID has been in Alaska for about 6 months. The handgun that SIRVID used to shoot the moose was a Ruger Black Hawk .41 magnum revolver. NCIC and ASPIN

checks on the handgun returned clear.

SA Jack Carney interviewed Mark DIORIOS at the DVC separate from SIRVID. SA Carney came to the scene and overheard SIRVID statements. SA Carney told me that SIRVID's statements basically matched DIORIOS. DIORIOS stated that when they saw the moose they stopped. They considered taking a photo but the moose started moving towards them. DIORIO stated he grabbed his daughter's (Isabella) arm and ran back with his wife and son. As they attempted to hide behind a tree they saw the moose running very fast towards them. At this point SIRVID shot the moose. DIORIO provided a written statement and relevant contact information was collected.

Based on the investigation and statements taken from the group it was determined that the moose had posed an immediate threat to the group and the SIRVID was justified in his actions. Though discharging a firearm within a National Park is prohibited [36 CFR § 2.4 (a) (1) (iii)], it was determine that SIRVID shot the moose to protect himself and the children. Alaska State Law allows a person to defend his or her self from wildlife if it poses a threat to life or property: Alaska Administrative Code (ACC) 92.410(b).

The moose was removed from the scene and the carcassed salvaged through AST charity. Ranger Hamilton oversaw the removal of the carcass.






