



Volunteer Job Summary

Title: Bike Ambassador, Gateway Multi-Use Path Patrol

Location: Gateway National Recreation Area, Sandy Hook Multi-Use Path

Skills Required:

- demonstrates strong interpersonal skills
- comfortable speaking to strangers
- able to engage visitors
- capable of clearly answering questions and giving directions
- interest in cultural and/or natural features of Sandy Hook
- currently certified or will to be certified in first-aid
- able to ride on a primarily flat service

Job Responsibilities:

In this position, the volunteer will act as an ambassador on the Multi-Use Path at Sandy Hook.

Volunteers will:

- ride, walk or rollerblade on a section of the multi-use path at least once per week
- interpret the history, significance and physical features of the park
- answer questions about the location of amenities such as the visitor center, restrooms, concessions, soda machines, ATM's, the ferry landing etc...
- provide basic assistance on the bikeway, which may include providing tools or spare parts for bike repairs, providing basic first aid (if certified), calling for assistance in case of emergency, or other visitor assistance
- participate in training programs as they are offered
- other duties as requested

Special Notes:

This position requires a working knowledge of Sandy Hook and the local area. Volunteers will receive a Quick Flip Reference Guide with basic information about Sandy Hook. A neat, clean VIP t-shirt must be worn while performing this position. All riding or rollerblading volunteers must wear a helmet. This is a 100% outdoor position. All volunteers must have a personal cellphone or park radio to contact Dispatch in an emergency.
