



Glacier Centennial Artist Application

You are invited to participate in the celebration of the first 100 years of Glacier National Park by creating official artwork for the Glacier National Park Centennial Celebration. The mission of the Centennial Celebration taking place in 2010 is “Celebrate, Inspire, Engage”. You are encouraged to create a visual representation of this theme through art forms. Specific artistic categories of art are: Painting, Photo, Sculpture, Textile, Graphic Design, and General. More detail on each category is provided on the application below. Also, please visit the Glacier Centennial website at www.glaciercentennial.org to learn more about our exciting Program and Celebration.

An artist selection committee (made up of artists, curators, and Centennial Committee Members) will select two winning artists from each category. In the event there are too few entries in any category, that category will be combined with another. A non-refundable review/application fee of \$25 is required with each application submission. Entering multiple pieces of art requires separate applications and each subsequent application requires an additional \$25 fee. Checks should be made payable to “Glacier Association” on behalf of the Glacier National Park Centennial. The winners grant Glacier National Park permission to display the work in a traveling exhibit and grant the Park permission to use an electronic image of your entry in Centennial Program materials, with appropriate credit. All twelve winning entries will be sold at a fundraising auction during 2010 with a portion of the proceeds (minimum of 50%) benefiting Glacier National Park’s four non-profit partners: Glacier National Park Fund, Glacier Association, Glacier Institute, and Glacier National Park Associates. The artist will be entitled to the remaining 50% of the auction proceeds or may choose to donate a higher portion.

This two (2) page application and fee must be completed and received no later than March 1, 2009. The winning artists will be sent notification no later than March 31, 2009. Following notification, Glacier National Park must receive the original piece(s)/artwork no later than May 1, 2009.

Entrants under the age of 18 years at the time of application must have a legal guardian signature to enter.

1.) Provide the reason you are submitting artwork for this contest. Briefly (max. 250 words) tell us how your submission expresses your feelings of Glacier National Park and how your piece will “Celebrate, Inspire, Engage” others in the future of Glacier National Park.

2.) Art entry is by digital files only. No slides. Digital files must be submitted in the form of CDS or DVDS. Digital files should be in a .jpeg (.jpg) format and no larger than 2 mb/file (we do not recommend that you send files smaller than 250 kb). File names should start with the artist’s lastname and include a brief title (Example: Smith_Logan Pass_Wildflowers.jpg)

Categories of Artwork

Below are the Categories of Artwork and various mediums that will be reviewed; this list is NOT intended to be comprehensive. If your artwork or medium does not fit into one of the first five specific categories, please include it under “General”.

Painting and Drawing: oil, acrylic, watercolor, chalk, pencil, etc;

Photography: black and white, color, etc;

Sculpture: metal, clay, pottery, etc;

Textile: fabric, fiber, etc;

Graphic design and Digital Art

General: That art which does not fit into any of the above categories.

Note – Individuals on the Artist Selection Committee and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate.
