


This is a special book for you to work on so that YOU can become a Pee Wee Ranger. Get out some crayons and pencils and get ready to learn about Glacier Bay.

What kind of wildlife do you think you might see? Be on the lookout for big brown bears and tiny colorful hummingbirds. Have fun coloring this picture.








Sea Science

Park Scientists study the underwater world of Glacier Bay. How many sea stars can you count?




Canoe Contest

The Tlingit Indians of Glacier Bay carve beautiful canoes. Circle the two canoes that are the same.




Glacier Bay Sights

Circle what you would most like to see in Glacier Bay.




Animal Homes

You can find animals in Glacier Bay on the land, in the air and under the water. Draw the animals on the previous page in the place where they might live.




Glacier Viewing


Kelp Maze

Something is not quite right. Circle what is wrong in this picture.




Wilderness Surprises

If you're very quiet, you can sometimes sneak up on a moose in the wilderness. But don't get too close to any wild animal!




Dinner Time
