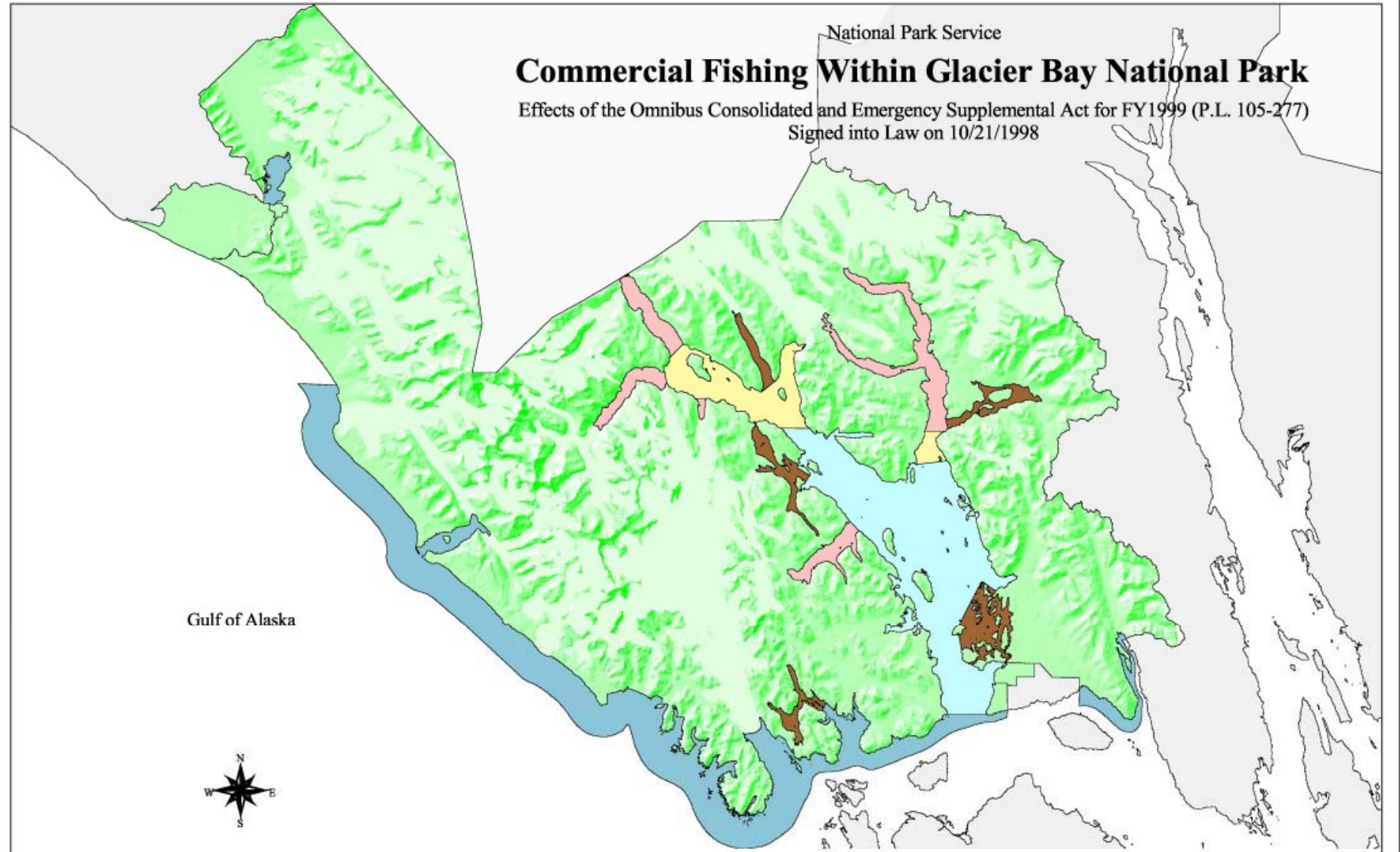





Effects of the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Act for FY1999 (P.L. 105-277)

-  Areas Open Only to Winter Season Commercial King Salmon Troll Fishery for Grandfathered Individuals Approx. 48,334 Acres
-  Non-Wilderness Areas Closed to Commercial Fisheries Approx. 61,964 Acres
-  Wilderness Areas Closed to Commercial Fisheries Approx. 47,930 Acres
