Employment Workshops to be Held at Coconino Community College

The National Park Service will host two workshops on how to apply for federal jobs at Coconino Community College, in Page, Arizona, on Tuesday, January 10 and Thursday, January 12, 2006. The workshops will provide information for people who may be interested in applying for jobs at Glen Canyon National Recreation Area, Navajo National Monument, and other national park sites or federal agencies.

The National Park Service hires a variety of seasonal positions. In addition, permanent positions with Glen Canyon National Recreation Area are also periodically available. Seasonal positions that may be filled in the upcoming months are wide ranging, and include law enforcement park rangers, interpretation rangers, maintenance employees, and natural and cultural resource technicians.

Staff from Glen Canyon's human resources office will be available to provide personalized attention and answer questions in an informal setting. Computers will also be available for people to gain familiarity with job websites. Topics to be covered include:

- How to use the Internet to search for federal jobs
- How to apply for jobs online (including demonstrations of the online application process)
- Jobs that may be available, qualifications required, pay, and benefits
- How to apply for a federal job and tips on writing federal applications

The workshops will be held on January 10 and 12 from 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm in Room A- 1 of Coconino Community College. Individuals may drop by at any time during those periods to meet with staff from Glen Canyon's human resources office.
