### **Glen Canyon Update for Fall and Winter 2007** *Shoulder Season is a Great Time to Explore Lake Powell!*

Page, AZ – Fall is a perfect time to visit Glen Canyon National Recreation Area! With fewer crowds, it's easy to find your own slice of paradise in this red rock wonderland. Whether you want to hike, kayak, fish, boat, or do all it, there is something for everyone here.

Hikers love the fall, thanks to cooler temperatures and dry weather. Hiking possibilities are nearly endless in the park. You can stretch your legs for a quick walk or take a multi- day backpacking trip.

Kayaking also offers a unique way to experience Lake Powell. With calm waters, kayakers can explore narrow side canyons and find plenty of opportunities for solitude. Kayakers can put their boats in at any launch ramp or get dropped off through a boat shuttle from Aramark or Antelope Point Holdings.

Value- season discounts for houseboat rentals are available at Antelope Point, Wahweap, and Bullfrog Marinas, making this a great time to book a trip.

Visitors should keep in mind that as the busy summer season winds down, the park's facilities and services will move to their winter schedule. Launch ramps at Wahweap, Stateline, Antelope Point, Bullfrog, and Halls Crossing are all open with concrete surfaces. The Lake Powell Resort at Wahweap will remain open all winter long, with breakfast, lunch, and dinner served at Java City or the Driftwood Lounge. While Defiance House Lodge at Bullfrog closes for the season on November 7, family housing units with complete kitchens are available at Bullfrog, Halls Crossing, and Hite throughout the winter.

Dangling Rope Marina will close for the season on November 27 and will reopen on March 1. Fuel will not be for sale at Dangling Rope this winter, so boaters should plan accordingly. Boat fuel will be available at Antelope Point, Bullfrog, Halls Crossing, and Wahweap Marinas throughout the winter.
