

DESIGNATION OF PARK AREAS AVAILABLE FOR FIRST AMENDMENT ACTIVITIES

The exercise of first amendment activities by any individual, group or organization within the jurisdiction of Golden Gate National Recreation Area shall be in compliance with the provisions of 36 CFR §2.51 Public assemblies, meetings and /or 36 CFR §2.52 Sale or distribution of printed matter. Such activities shall also be subject to and in compliance with other laws and regulations applicable to Golden Gate National Recreation Area, the Presidio of San Francisco, Muir Woods National Monument and Fort Point National Historic Site.

Section I: Established Zones

In accord with and consistent with 36 CFR §2.51 and §2.52, the Superintendent will issue permits for the exercise of first amendment activities in the following designated areas:

A. Crissy Field

1. West Bluff Picnic Area: An Area approximately fifty (50) feet by one hundred (100) feet, set back five (5) feet from the promenade, located at the north end of the picnic site outside the amphitheater. **(Exhibit #3)**
2. East Beach Parking: An area approximately fifty (50) feet by one hundred (100) feet, set back five (5) feet from the promenade, located at the base of the overlook dune at the northeast corner of the parking area. **(Exhibit #4)**
3. Airfield: An area approximately fifty (50) feet by one hundred (100) feet, set back five (5) feet from the promenade, located at the intersection of the Promenade and the eastern access sidewalk. **(Exhibit #5)**

B. Fort Mason

1. Lower Fort Mason: An area approximately twenty (20) feet by ten (10) feet located directly across the street from the Gatehouse and directly behind the entrance gate to Lower Ft. Mason.
2. Piers Two and Three: Located fifty (50) feet directly south of the entrance to Piers Two and Three. The area is fifteen (15) feet by fifty (50) feet and bordered by the solid white line of the westbound traffic lane.

C. Fort Point

1. Fort Point Lawn: An area approximately fifty (50) feet by fifty (50) feet, set back five (5) feet from the roadway, located at Fort Point on the grass lawn at the northern terminus of Marine Drive (**Exhibit #2**)

D. Muir Woods National Monument

1. Muir Woods Parking: An area approximately ten (10) feet by twenty (20) feet between the upper and lower parking areas, adjacent to the north side of the comfort station facility.

E. Muir Beach

1. Muir Beach Parking: An area approximately ten (10) feet by twenty (20) feet as marked on the ground adjacent to the public telephone.

F. Stinson Beach

1. Stinson Beach: An area approximately twenty (20) feet by ten (10) feet, located at the south corner of the picnic area between the north and central parking lots.


G. Alcatraz Island

1. No permits will be issued for the sale or distribution of printed matter under 36 CFR §2.52.
2. Permits will, if not inconsistent with the criteria therein, be issued for activities authorized under 36 CFR §2.51, public assemblies.

Section II: Special Areas or Situations

- A. Special Events or Activities:** Individuals or groups wishing to exercise first amendment rights in relation to a special event or activity within Golden Gate National Recreation Area may apply to the Superintendent for the designation of an additional First Amendment Area. Upon receipt of an application, the Superintendent will, if not inconsistent with the criteria in 36 CFR §2.51 and §2.52, identify and make available a specific location for the exercise of First Amendment activities in accordance with the conditions and restrictions found in 36 CFR §2.51 and §2.52. These sites are temporary and will only exist during the time frame designated within the permit.


- B.** No permit will be issued for activities covered under 36 CFR §2.51 and §2.52 within any area permanently or temporarily closed by the Superintendent under the authority granted by 36 CFR §1.5(a)(1).
- C.** Sound amplification is prohibited.










Crissy Field Boundary





FORT FUNSTON HANG GLIDING REGULATIONS

1. Hang Gliding is permitted from the Fort Funston site under Special Regulations of 36 CFR 7.97(b). In addition, the use of hang gliders will be in accordance with the Federal Aviation Administration regulation of ultralight vehicles in 14 CFR Chapter 1, Part 103. Violation of these regulations is prohibited and may result in a citation and/or suspension of the privilege to use the area.
2. Hang Gliding at the Fort Funston site is further regulated and managed through permit requirements and regulations specific to the site which are posted at Fort Funston and are available from the Superintendent's Office.

ABBREVIATED VERSION FORT FUNSTON HANG GLIDING RULES MAY 1994

1. Pilot Qualifications: To fulfill the annual registration requirements, each hang glider pilot must comply with the following:
 - A. Present a current membership card of the United States Hang Gliding Association (USHGA), to confirm their hang-gliding pilot liability and insurance policy
 - B. Have a USHGA Hang III (Intermediate) level rating or equivalent. Pilots with a USHGA Hang II (Novice) rating are not permitted to soar at Fort Funston, but may fly to the beach under the guidelines specified in the Fort Funston hang gliding regulations. Upon achieving the USHGA Hang III (Intermediate) rating or equivalent, the pilot will be eligible to acquire a current Fort Funston permit sticker in order to soar at Fort Funston.

The following rules must be followed by every pilot using Fort Funston launch and landing site.

- a. Any violation of the Terminal Control Area (2100 feet vertical) jeopardizes the site and would be dealt with penalties by Fellow Feather's Club officers and/or the National Park Service's District Ranger.
- b. No pilot may fly within 25 feet of any person on the ground. Pilots must yield to people on horseback. No pilot

may launch when there are spectators in the launch area. Courtesy is mandatory of all pilots at all times.

c. Pilots must fly straight and level in the launch window. The launch window is from the stairs just south of launch, to the north end of the deck, 100 feet up and 100 feet out.

d. Pilots must fly safely and courteously, clearing all turns and maneuvers, and observing International Ridge Soaring Rules.

e. Pilots must launch from the designated launch area only. The landing zone is the field to the south of the parking lot and should be used whenever possible.

f. Pilots flying south of the bowl must carry current Westlake ratings and carry a valid and current Westlake sticker.

g. Pilots must be a current member of the United States Hang Gliding Association (USHGA) or show proof of equivalent insurance coverage. Pilots must possess proof of at least an USHGA Intermediate Hang III rating. Current Fort Funston stickers are required and must be worn on helmets.

h. Pilots must remain clear of clouds and fog. **No launching or flying after sunset.**

i. Any Hang II launch must be sponsored by an experienced Funston pilot. A Hang II may not soar or fly north of the Daly City sewer outfall pipe on Fort Funston Beach and must glide directly to the beach.

j. No motorized, experimental, paragliding or tandem flying is allowed from Fort Funston. No flying north of the "gap" from April 1, to August 15, 1994 to protect the bank swallow nest habitat.

k. **Olympic Club Easement:** When winds are less than 13 miles per hour no more than eight hang gliders and eight paragliders are allowed to fly at the same time. Wind measured at Fort Funston launch.

l. **West Lake Cliffs:** When winds are less than 13 miles per hour no more than fifteen hang gliders and eight paragliders are allowed to fly at the same time. Wind measured at Fort Funston launch.

m. Motorized Hang Gliding is absolutely forbidden.

ABBREVIATED VERSION
Olympic Club Easement Paragliding Rules
MAY 1994

Paragliding pilots must be registered and obtain an annual permit sticker from the Bay Area Paragliding Association representative each year to be eligible to paraglide at the Stables Launch Area on the Olympic Club Easement (GGNRA). The permit system will be coordinated by the local chapter of the Bay Area Paragliding Association under the supervision of the National Park Service.

To fulfill the annual registration requirements, each paragliding pilot must comply with the following:

- a. Present a current membership card of the United States Hang Gliding association (USHGA), to confirm their hang-gliding pilot\paragliding pilot liability or submit a copy of an insurance policy.

Flight Zone Restrictions: Landing and launching of paragliders is only allowed at the designated landing zone known as the stables launch site.

- a. Paragliders are not allowed to fly into Fort Funston's air space.
- b. Paragliders will not fly beyond the knob in the south end of the old training bowl area on Olympic Club lands.
- c. Paragliders are allowed to fly south over all GGNRA property including Westlake and Philip Burton Memorial Beach.
- d. Paragliders will not fly within 200 feet of Westlake houses to protect the privacy of homeowners. National Park Service personnel will respond to homeowner complaints.

33. Rating: All Paragliders landing or launching from the Stables or Southern Launch site will be a registered USHGA Class II rating holder. Each register pilot will have met the prerequisite

of a minimum of 25 hours over 50 days of logged flying time over a minimum period of six months. Documents such as a flight log book must document each pilots flight training. In addition to the above, each pilot will be issued a Stables Launch site sticker which will be recorded with the local Bay Area Paragliding Association and with the National Park Service.

34. Altitude Restrictions: Paragliders will not fly above the elevation of the upper golf course when they are within 200 feet west of the fairway. When wind conditions permit and elevations

are attainable, paragliders may fly 500 feet over the Olympic Club lands.

35. Commercial Training and Instruction: Commercial training and instruction is prohibited. All pilots must have a USHGA II rating.

36. Stunt Flying and aerobatics: Stunt and aerobatic flying is prohibited.

37. Prohibition of Tandem Flying: No tandem flying is allowed over National Park Service lands.

38. Information Board and First Aid Box: A post mounted bulletin board and a First Aid Box will be allowed to be erected by the local Paragliding Club by approval of the General Superintendent or his designee.

39. Protection of Natural Resources: The stables\Southern launch site will be protected to prevent erosion and trampling of vegetation. The use of this area will be monitored by the National Park Service ranger staff. It is the club's responsibility to maintain, restore and protect the launch and landing site and access trail from the parking lot as instructed by the National Park Service's Natural Resources Specialist.

40. Olympic Club Easement: When winds are less than 13 miles per hour no more than eight hang gliders and eight paragliders are allowed to fly at the same time. Wind measured at Fort Funston launch.

41. West Lake Cliffs: When winds are less than 13 miles per hour no more than fifteen hang gliders and eight paragliders are allowed to fly at the same time. Wind measured at Fort Funston launch.

a. Paragliders will observe and respect the traffic paths of hang gliders.

b. Paragliding pilots will keep a sharp eye out for approaching hang gliders and look for on coming traffic before executing turns or changes in elevation (big ship-- little ship rule).

Authorized NPS law enforcement personnel have the ultimate or "final" authority over flying at Fort Funston and on Olympic Club Easement and park lands south.

Point Reyes National Seashore

1. Olema Valley

Leashed dogs permitted where signed.

2. Bolinas Ridge

Leashed dogs permitted where signed.

3. Stinson Beach

Leashed dogs permitted in parking lots and picnic areas. Dogs NOT permitted on beach.

4. Tennessee Valley

Dogs NOT permitted in Tennessee Valley. Leashed dogs permitted on Miwok Trail north of Tennessee Valley.

5. Oakwood Valley

Leashed dogs Allowed on desinated trails.

6. Marin Headlands

Leashed dogs permitted on designated trails and beach areas. Dogs NOT permitted in Rodeo Lagoon.

7. Fort Baker

Leashed dogs permitted in designated areas. Dogs NOT allowed on pier.

8. Presidio / Crissy Field

Leashed dogs permitted except on designated habitat / wildlife protection areas. Dogs NOT permitted on Lobos Creek boardwalk.

9. China Beach

Dogs NOT permitted.

10. Cliff House / Lands End

Leashed dogs permitted, outside buildings.

11. Ocean Beach

Leashed dogs permitted, except in designated habitat / wildlife protection areas.

12. Muir Beach

Leashed dogs permitted on designated trails and beach areas. No dogs allowed in the lagoon or Redwood Creek.

13. Muir Woods

Dogs NOT permitted.

14. Homestead Valley

Leashed dogs permitted.

15. Alcatraz

Dogs NOT permitted.

16. Fort Point

Leashed dogs permitted, except in historic fort. Dogs NOT permitted on pier.

17. Fort Mason

Leashed dogs permitted.

18. Fort Funston

Leashed dogs permitted, except in designated habitat / wildlife protection areas.

19. Milagra Ridge

Leashed dogs permitted.

20. Sweeney Ridge

Leashed dogs permitted.

21. Phleger Estate

Dogs NOT permitted
