<b>Way Cool Canyon</b>    <p>A ranger presents activities, games, and stories that hone your senses and open your eyes to the environment of the North Rim. <b>Into the Past</b>   <p>How did the people at Grand Canyon survive hundreds and even thousands of years ago? Discover the powerful ties between people and place. <b>What's Rockin'? - Grand Canyon Geology</b>   <p>Why is Grand Canyon here and not in your backyard? Enjoy a ranger talk and then test your new skills with a short, optional stroll to Bright Angel Point. <b>Condor Talk</b>    <p>What has a 9-foot/2.7 m wingspan and a face only a mother could love? The California condor. <b>Evening Program</b> <p>A variety of programs explore the scenic, scientific, and cultural aspects of this special landscape. Nightly topics are posted in the lodge, visitor center, and campground.
