This scholarship program recognizes educational excellence and outstanding public service in honor of the renowned Dr. Carver – Educator, Scientist, and Humanitarian. This scholarship opportunity is designed to inspire the creative minds of young people who are seeking a post high school education in Science, Art, Agriculture, Music, Education or Bible. The amount of the award is \$500.00 for the 2009/10 academic year (\$250.00/semester). To be considered eligible, an applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Must be graduating from an accredited local high school in the spring of 2009 and be eligible for enrollment in college by the fall of 2009, or be completing a high school equivalent home school program in the spring of 2009 and be eligible for enrollment in college by the fall of 2009.
- 2. Be pursuing study in one of the following disciplines: Science, Art, Agriculture, Music, Education or Bible.
- 3. Attend an accredited college (2 or 4 years) within 75 miles of George Washington Carver National Monument; or attend Iowa State University, Tuskegee University, or Simpson College in Indianola, Iowa.
- 4. Criteria used to award scholarship include: need, academic achievement and community involvement.
- 5. If selected as a finalist, applicants must complete an interview with the scholarship committee.
