Summer Junior Ranger Program

Registration is open for Summer Junior Rangers at George Washington Carver National Monument. This fun program is geared for girls and boys from 10 to 12 years of age. The dates for the Summer Junior Ranger sessions are June 9th, June 16th, and June 23rd from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and kids are encouraged to attend all three sessions.

Several exciting activities are planned to help Junior Rangers explore park grounds while learning more about the life of George Washington Carver. Junior Rangers will learn what it is like to be a park ranger by conducting science experiments with sweet potatoes, creating color swatches to study tints and shades, studying genealogy at the Carver Family Cemetery, conducting research and working together to make a museum exhibit, discovering plant taxonomy, reading tree cookies to find out about the life of a tree, and much more. To conclude their experience, Summer Junior Rangers will provide a guided tour on the last day!
