

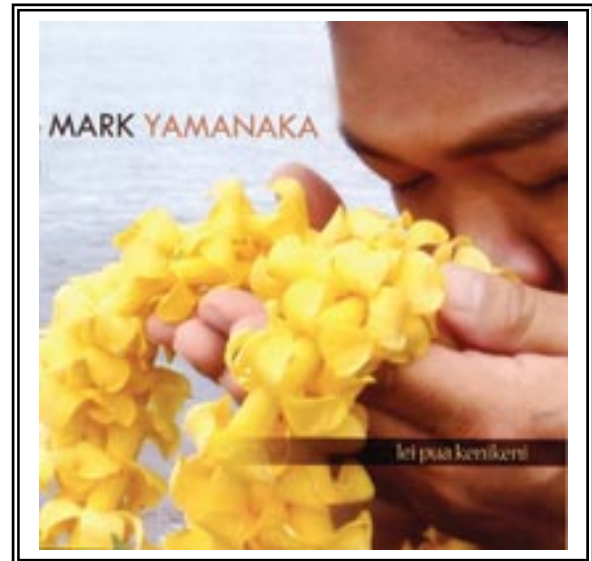

This Hawai'i island recording artist won 4 awards at the 2011, 34th annual Nā Hōkū Hanohano Awards. He matched the first-time successes of Hawaiian music superstars Willie K. and Keali'i Reichel. Mark's debut CD, "Lei Pua Kenikeni," won Album of the Year, Male Vocalist of the Year, Most Promising Artist, and Song of the Year. Mark is the third musician to take all categories with his debut CD.

Mark is no stranger to the music scene and has been in the music business for many years playing all over Hawai'i island, the outer islands, the mainland and Japan. He is also featured on another CD with friends Brandon and Emma Nakano as the Keawe Trio who also released a CD together.

He has been featured on numerous programs including KCCN's Morning Drive Breakfast Show, Pakele Live on OC16, Hot Hawaiian Nights, Seattle Slack Key Festival, Prince Kuhio Plaza in Hilo and Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park's cultural festival and Nā Leo Manu series.
