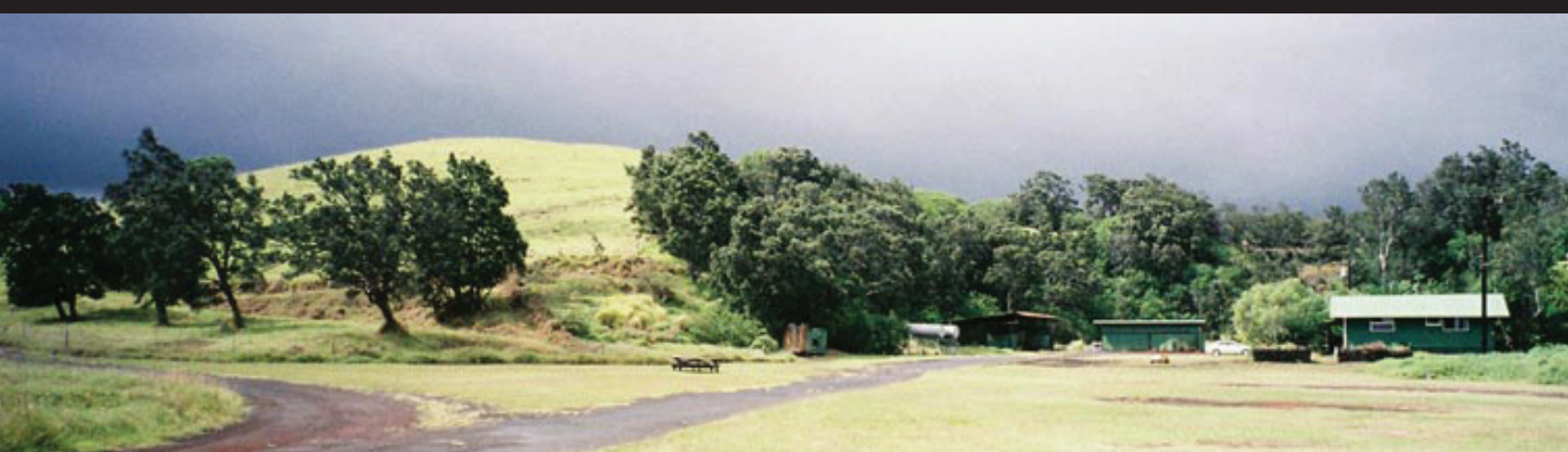


People and Land of Kahuku



When: Oct 22, Nov 13, Nov 19, Dec 4 and Dec 10, 2011, Jan 15 and Jan 22, 2012 from 9:30-12:30

Where: Meet at the Park's Kahuku Unit, Ka'ū. The gate, located off Hwy 11 near mile marker 70, will be opened at 9 am. Park and meet inside the gate near the ranch buildings. Boots and long pants are recommended.

What: Hike 2 miles, 3 hours through pastures, quarry, airstrip and the extraordinary 1868 lava fields.

▶ **Learn how people lived on the vast Kahuku lands, from the earliest Hawaiians through today.**

▶ **Hear about Kahuku's history of violent earthquakes and eruptions and the people who survived them.**

▶ **Walk through an emerging native forest to explore 1868 volcanic vents and flows.**

▶ **Learn Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park's plans to restore native ecosystems and protect cultural sites.**
