







Aids to Navigation

Channel Markers (entering from seaward)

- Port (odd numbered) Lights flash green
- Starboard (even numbered) Lights flash red
- Diver's Flag

Regulatory Flags

- Keep out
- Danger
- Speed Limit (No wake-5mph)

Storm Warning Flags

- Small craft advisory (20-38 mph winds)
- Gale (39-54 mph winds)
- Storm or whole gale (55-73 mph winds)
- Hurricane (74 mph winds or higher)

Channel Buoys (traveling upstream)

- Port (left) buoy
- Starboard (right) buoy
- Mid-Channel buoy (unlighted)
- Mid-Channel buoy (white light)
