Position Duties

- Learn proper safety and technical aspects of invasive plant control, including use of equipment, application of chemical herbicide, identification of invasive and native plants, and when to use different techniques for invasive plant control
- Perform routine invasive plant control using hand, mechanical, and chemical methods
- Learn proper use of GPS equipment and software to document and map areas of control
- Occasionally assist with survey work of birds, herpetofauna, and invertebrates

- Practical knowledge of terminology, methods, and practices of one or more of the biological sciences
- Some knowledge of natural resource management practices pertaining to invasive plant control
