Summary: “Developing Young Leaders” will build upon the success of Lowell’s current and long term partnership with Community Teamwork, Inc. by creating a year-round program that unites young people between the ages of 15 and 21 years for a demanding schedule of community service and leadership development. It will encourage, prepare, and challenge young people from diverse backgrounds to address environmental and social issues in their community, while introducing them to a variety of possible conservation-related career fields. Drawing from the local high schools and the community college, the membership will strive to be racially, culturally and economically diverse to reflect Lowell’s population.
