National Park Service Honors Lady Bird Johnson in Washington, D.C. Metro Area

Washington, D.C. - Join the National Park Service in honoring Lady Bird Johnson along the George Washington Memorial Parkway this weekend. A remembrance tent will be staffed by a ranger at Columbia Island in Lady Bird Johnson Park from 10:00 a.m. – 7:30 p.m. from Friday – Sunday. Remembrance books will be available at a table in the tent for the public to share thoughts about Lady Bird and her legacy. In addition, visitors are encouraged to spend time in Lady Bird Johnson Park throughout the weekend. On Sunday, July 15, from 1:00 – 1:30 p.m., the National Park Service will host *A Tribute to Lady Bird Johnson* for the public in Lyndon Baines Johnson Memorial Grove.

Parking is *extremely limited* at Columbia Island Marina. Therefore, the National Park Service strongly recommends visitors use the Pentagon Metro and walk approximately 20 minutes to the northeast corner of the Pentagon. Then, visitors may cross a pedestrian bridge across Boundary Channel to Lyndon Baines Johnson Memorial Grove. (NOTE: For Metro schedules, visit www.metroopensdoors.com.)

Driving Directions: Lady Bird Johnson Park is situated between George Washington Memorial Parkway (Parkway) and the Potomac River south of Theodore Roosevelt Island and north of the 14th Street Bridge.

From I-495: Exit at George Washington Memorial Parkway. Drive south along the Parkway for approximately 12 miles to Columbia Island Marina. Take a right. Take another right and park near the end of the lot at the entrance to the Lyndon Baines Johnson Memorial Grove.

From the West and East: Once on the southbound George Washington Memorial Parkway, exit to the right at the Columbia Island Marina. Take another right and park at the end of the lot at the entrance to Lyndon Baines Johnson Memorial Grove.

From the South: Drive north along George Washington Memorial Parkway. Take a left into the Columbia Island Marina. Take another right and park near the end of the lot at the entrance to the Lyndon Baines Johnson Memorial Grove.
