

Education Program Reservation Request



Manzanar National Historic Site is located six miles south of Independence, California at 5001 Hwy. 395. The site is open daily from sunrise to sunset. Our Interpretive Center is open every day of the year except December 25. From April 1 through October 31 we are open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. daily; from November 1 through March 31 we are open from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Admission is free.

With our extensive exhibits, introductory film, and self-guided auto tour, teachers can lead their own excursion to Manzanar. When staffing allows, we also offer ranger-guided programs which range from brief overview talks to step-on bus tours and/or in-depth walking tours. **To request a program reservation please complete this form and fax it to 760-878-2949 at least two weeks in advance.** A ranger will call to confirm the date and time of your program.
