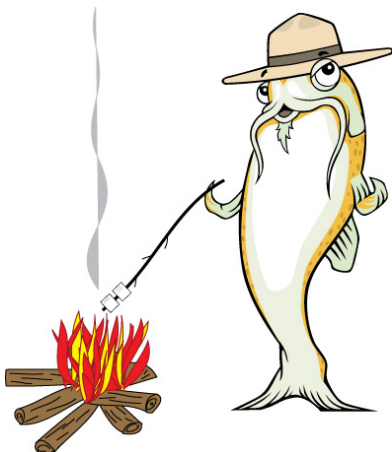
## Dear Junior Rangers,

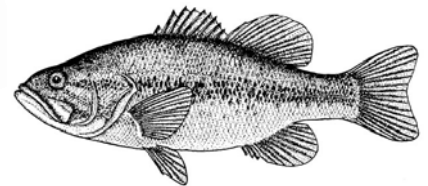
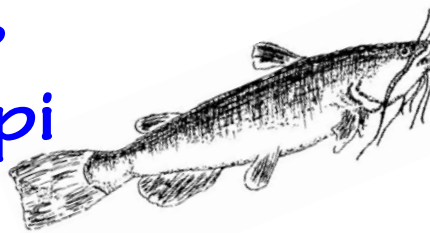
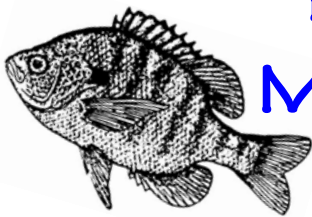
