**3. If yes, please give a short description of the features of your park and main areas of current work:**

The Kra National Park was proclaimed a national Park in 1985. It is located in the Sibenik and Knin country, and occupies an area of 109 square km, along the course of the Krka river. The Krka river rises at the foot of Mount Dinara not far from Knin. With the drowned part of the mouth, it is about 72 km long. The mean annual flow across Skradinski (waterfall) is 55m<sup>3</sup>/s and when there are heavy rains in the interland this can rise to over 350.. Krka, with its 7 travertine waterfalls, is a phenomenon of nature and the karst.
