




Reptile & Amphibian Checklist

This checklist includes observations reported by National Park Service employees and visitors since North Cascades National Park Service Complex was established in 1968. A species is listed if at least one sighting has occurred, or a specimen collected. An observation outside North Cascades is included if within 6 miles (10 km) of the boundary. An asterisk (*) denotes a species whose presence is suspected based on its general distribution, but for which there are no records. We encourage you to report any reptile and amphibian sightings to a ranger station, particularly if a species is unlisted.






