Camping at Organ Pipe Cactus



Campsites	One RV and/or tent per site OR two tents with maximum of six persons per site only. Maximum of two vehicles per campsite. If assigned a specific site, do not switch sites.
Electrical Hookups	Electrical hookups are NOT available. Restroom outlets are only for use of personal hygiene appliances. All other uses, including use of extension cords or recharging items is prohibited.
Trailer & Motorhome Length	Length of RV is not to exceed 40 feet (motorhome is measured bumper to bumper; trailer is measured from hitch point to rear bumper). Length of 5th-wheel style camper is not to exceed 35 feet (measurement does not include tow vehicle).
Tents	In sites without tent pads, please use cleared area next to the picnic table. Do not disturb natural desert areas between campsites.
Vehicles	Vehicles MUST park on pavement on site. Drivers must observe one way traffic pattern. Motor vehicles may not be operated with an auxiliary side mirror that extends more than six inches beyond the side fender line on either side except when towing a second vehicle or trailer. Washing vehicles in the campground is prohibited.
Quiet Hours	10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Generator hours are 8:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m. ONLY Idling of engines for longer than 5 minutes prohibited
Length of Stay	Camping is limited to 14 calendar days from November 15 through April 15, and 14 days for the rest of the year, for a maximum of 28 days per calendar year. Check out time is 11:00 a.m.
Group Camping	Group sites are available by reservation only. Please call the Monument at (520) 387- 6849 for more information.
Fires	Ground fires are prohibited. Confine all fires or the grills provided. Selfcontained grills may be used.
Wood Collection	Using or possessing native wood gathered within the park is prohibited.
Sanitation	Wash dishes only at your campsite. Outside faucets are for drinking water only; all other uses are prohibited. Dispose of dishwasher and gray water in the waste sink at each restroom. Sewage will be disposed of only at the dump station. Please use the receptacles provided for recycling.
Pets	Pets must be on leash or under physical restraint at all times. They are not allowed in the restrooms or on trails except the Campground Perimeter Trail and Palo Verde Trail. For sanitation reasons, you are required to use the PET AREAS on the OUTSIDE of the campground perimeter Trail. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET. Do not leave pets unattended in campsite.
Bicycles	Cyclists must obey vehicle regulations. Cyclists are allowed on the same routes as vehicles, but do not have to follow one way traffic pattern. Bicycles are prohibited on foot trails and in the backcountry.
