Padre Island National Seashore Academic Fee Waiver Information

Criteria for Approving Requests for Academic Fee Waivers

Academic Fee Waivers are for outings conducted for non-commercial educational purposes by schools and other bona fide academic institutions. Educational groups must apply and meet the criteria to receive a fee waiver. There are three criteria to qualify for an academic fee waiver: bona fide academic institution, educational purpose and relevance of park resources or facilities. Please read carefully. Your application package must contain the following documentation:

1. Eligibility

Applicants must prove they are a bona fide academic institution by submitting the following:

• A statement from an accredited educational institution confirming that <u>the group is visiting for</u> the purpose of providing academic credit based on a curriculum.

• A statement of accreditation or recognition as an educational institution from a legitimate international, national, regional, state, or local authority for the applicant's location.

2. Educational Purpose of the Visit

Applicants must provide a written statement verifying that the visit supports specific curriculum for which academic credit is offered.

3. Relevance of Park Resources or Facilities

Relevance to park resources must be described. (In other words, explain why your activities must be done at the national seashore.) Applicants must provide a written statement identifying the park resources and/or facilities that will be used to support the educational purpose of the visit, and how they are relevant to that purpose.


Home Schools

Home schools may be granted fee waivers based on the course of study following the procedures above, as long as they meet their state's requirements for home schools.

NOTE: Not-for-profit groups such as service, civic, fraternal organizations, scouts, 4-H, Road Scholar etc., do not typically qualify for an academic fee waiver.

General Guidelines

Please complete the following Fee Waiver Application Form using the criteria described above, and return it to us as soon as possible. If approved, an educational fee waiver will be e-mailed to you. Allow 4-6 weeks for processing.
