make and Publish this my Last will Testament in Manner
following that is to say First I nominate and Appoint my beloved
Wife Christine and Peter Huber and my Son Peter Piffer to be
my Executors in this my Last will Testament and also recommend
my Body to Decently to be buried To the Discretion of my Executors
first I give to my beloved Wife Christine the house on the old place
is called the new house during her life and my Son Peter Piffer
to find his Mother in fee simple during her life and keep for his Mother one
hundred pounds during her life and also one hundred pounds of Pork
During her life and equally During her life ten bushels of wheat
Ten bushels of rye and ten bushels of Buckwheat Every such
thing to be given to the house above mentioned in each
is to take after this will she and another build the said wall
both and other articles she may leave and spend the Money or else
in my house After my Decease I give to her own use and also
will my sole devise Estate of appomattox Township
unto Peter Huber Frederick Piffer and Peter Piffer and their
unborn in the following manner first my Daughter Mary
to Peter Huber a portion of land between the two
the lower hill and the hill on the side of
the Foxhouse and the old buildings there to be the place and
My Daughter Mary is to have one other Tract of Land of thirty two
Acres build near Abraham Lubau and joining said Lubau Land
and I also purgess to my Daughter Mary and Peter Huber the
Boyz debt start charged against them and the said Peter
Huber is to pay out of said Estate Six hundred pounds in
such manner to my other children that is to say fifty pounds
After my decease and for they Reasons that my Son Peter
Piffer to have such part of Estate as follows
Land and to the sum between him and his Brother Peter
To the whole place to the Creek and he is also to keep for
his place four hundred pounds out of the Reservoir of my child
that is to say Twenty five pounds yearly after my Decease and my
Son Peter Piffer is to keep for his share of his Land the said place
with all the buildings between him and his Brother Frederick
Piffer and Peter Huber one Thousand Pounds in the manner
following that is to say fifty Pounds yearly after my Decease

for five years of the Apples and other fruit trees the hole of the ground
To the sale use of my Son Peter Piffer for his own self and all the rest
house and lands that are willed to my Daughter Anna Mariana
To Peter Haeser to be and remain in full to them and here lies
for Eva and it is also my will if my two Sons Frederick and
Peter Piffer shal sell the land which is called the Hunde of our
land for the purpose of clearing up land journey all the money they
shall sell for shall be equally divided among all my children
further it is also my will if my Son Frederick Piffer shall chuse
to move or to some other country he is to have only an annuity
shame with the Remender of my other children and also
to let this Recumented in this my last will stand I further that
My daughter Anna Mariana shall have to Peter Piffer my house
and property that she may take in part as she sees fit and
the Remainder part of my Personall Property to be sold and
equally divided among my children that is to say to my
Son Samuel Piffer the eldest son one hundred pounds
and then to my Son Jacob Piffer the youngell among one
hundred Pounds and then to my Son Christian Piffer the next
after Jacob Piffer one hundred Pounds and then to my Son
Michael Piffer the younger child of Piffer one hundred
Pounds and then to my Daughter Anna Mariana one hundred
Pounds and then to my Son John Piffer one hundred Pounds
and so aperte from the eldest to the youngest until the
hole is paid with out each of my children an annuity
of one hundred dollars to be charged into my Book and I do hereby command
that my two Sons Frederick and Peter Piffer shall not pay any
Money to any of My Executors out of those places until two years
after my Decease This is hereby made this my last will

deponents and affiant's knowledge and belief: And also that they signed
the same as witnesses in the presence and at the request of the said testator
