Township in the County of Northampton on the Sixteenth Day of  
March in the year 1812 being sick in Body but of sound Memory  
much and Publish this my last will Testament in Manner  
following that is to say First I nominate and Appoint my beloved  
Wife Christina and Peter Kucher and my son Peter Piffer to be  
my Executors in this my last will Testament and I also recommend  
my Body to Deuently to be buried to the Discretion of my Executors  
first I gave to my beloved Wife Christina the house on the old place  
is called the new house during her life and my son Peter Piffer  
to find his Mother in firewood during her life and help for his Mother  
and I also gave during her life and also one hundred pounds of Port wine  
during her life and yearly during her life ten bushels of wheat  
Ten bushels of rye and ten bushels of Pease and every such  
things to be levied to the house above mentioned and I also give  
is to give at his will his land and one other land he shall will  
both and other articles she may be in need of and the Money or cash  
in my house after my Decease I give to his own use and I also  
will my whole Real Estate of uppermirethel Township  
unto Peter Kucher Frederick Piffer and Peter Piffer and they  
are to pay in the following Manner first my Daughter  
to Peter Kucher one Stone house in the hill called the  
house the house in the hill and the old building beside the house  
the Tavern house and the old building beside the house  
My Daughter Mary is to have one other Tract of Land of thirty two  
Acre land near Abraham Labors and joining Said Labors Land  
and I also forgive to my Daughter Mary and Peter Kucher the  
Bonds Debt and Charges due to them and the Said Peter  
Kucher is to pay out of Said Estate six hundred pounds or  
such amount to my other Children that is to say fifty pounds  
after my Decease and further Recommend that my son Peter  
Piffer is to have such part of Real Estate of uppermirethel  
Labors and to the same between him and his Brother Peter Piffer  
Till the whole place to the last Credit and he is also to pay for  
his place four hundred pounds out to the Account of my Children  
that is to say Twenty five pounds yearly after my Decease and my  
son Peter Piffer is to pay for his Share of his Land the old place  
with all the buildings between him and his Brother Frederick  
Piffer and Peter Kucher one Thousand Pounds in the manner  
following that is to say fifty Pounds yearly after my Decease

unto the Remembrance of other Children that is to say fifty Pounds yearly  
after my Decease and my son Peter Ripper is to have Twenty five pounds of  
Timber Land in woods of the Land called Robert Strills Land and in woods  
of the sd Trust and I also recommend if my son Frederick Ripper should  
Move of from my place now willed to him by me he is to sell his  
place the hole of the place is to Cornet Peter Ripper by paying  
him the value thereof if he the Frederick Ripper be dead his  
on the hole and I also recommend under that Peter Ripper and  
my son Frederick Ripper be unrequie shear of all the affectures  
for five years of the Affes and after that Time the hole of the wood  
to be Release of my son Peter Ripper for five years and also the  
house and lands I have willed to my daughter Mary Married  
To Peter Kuebert be and Remine in full to them and their Heirs  
for ever and it is also my Will if my two Sons Frederick and  
Peter Ripper should sell the land which is called the blude of quarry  
land for the Purpose of selling a sheld of quarry all the Money they  
shall sell for shall be equally divided among all my Children  
further it is also my will if my son Frederick Ripper should chuse  
to move of to some other Country he is to have only an unrequie  
share with the Remembrance of my other Children and also  
to be this Recommended in this my Last will and Testament that if  
my wife and I have willed should chuse to Judge among my thought  
ble Property that she may Judge any part as she sees fit and  
the Remning part of my Personall Property to be sold and  
unrequie divided among my Children that is to say to my  
son Samuel Ripper the eldest son one hundred pounds  
and then to my son Jacob Ripper the year following one  
hundred Pounds and then to my son Christian Ripper the year  
after Jacob Ripper one hundred Pounds and then to my son  
Michael Ripper the year after Christian Ripper one hundred  
Pounds and then to my daughter Christiane Married to  
William Fish after Michael Ripper one hundred Pounds  
and then to my son John Ripper one hundred Pounds  
and so yearly from the sd date to the year next until the  
hole is paid with out lack of my Childrens true Record  
of me changed into my Book and I do hereby Recommend  
that my two Sons Frederick and Peter Ripper shall not pay any  
Money to any of my Executors out of those places until two years  
after my Decease There is hereby made this my Last will

and Testament to Reunite in full rights all my children  
and my Executors by the full content and meaning therein  
Mentioned I have herewith set my hand and Seal the date

the same as witnesses in the presence and at the request of the said testator
