MID-SEASON REPORT

Docent Stats: Over the past 5 weeks

- 134 combined docent hours
- 1335 visitor contacts: 1061 trail contacts, 140 parking lot contacts, & 134 beach/trail contacts
- 95% of visitors contacted on weekends between 10 am and 4:30 pm have shown awareness and/or interest

The Plover News as of June 22nd, 2007

- **22** nests so far/ 5 re-nests
 - 25% egg loss: predation, tides and unknown factors
- **6** nests are being incubated (16-18 potential chicks)
 - 56% hatch success so far (37 eggs hatched/66 eggs laid)
 - So far **3** nests have been found in the restored dune area
- **5** broods are running around the beach (10 chicks)
 - 59% chick loss (22 birds): predation and/or unknown factors
- **5** chicks fledged
 - 13% fledgling success (5/37 eggs hatched)
