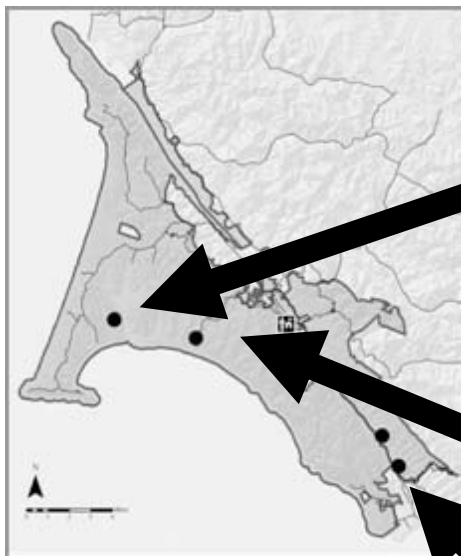


Prescribed Fire in S.F. Bay Area National Parks - 2011



LATE SUMMER 2011 – Golden Gate NRA

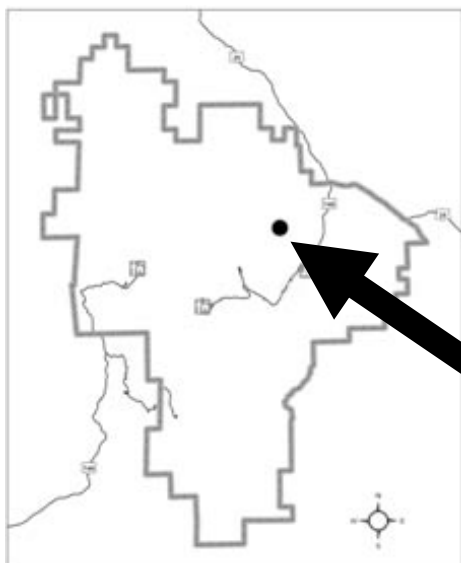
Gerbode burn – 30 acres to remove tall fescue, an invasive, non-native grass within a 60-acre restoration site



LATE SUMMER TO FALL 2011 – Point Reyes National Seashore

Clover reintroduction burn boxes – 1 acre or less to compare the effects of burning, grazing and no treatment on an experimental population of Showy Indian Clover, a nearly extinct plant that was recently reintroduced to Point Reyes

Limantour burn – 40 acres to create a strategic fuel break along Limantour Road



FALL 2011 – Pinnacles National Monument

McCabe Canyon burn - 5 acres to restore stands of deergrass which are naturally and culturally significant
