January 3, 4, 10, 11, 17, 18, 24, 25, 31 **9:00 a.m.** **Desert Morning Hike** *4 Mile Guided Hike*

Join volunteer Dick Hollenback on this 3-hour, 4-mile hike to explore Saguaro National Park. Wear sturdy hiking boots and bring water and a trail snack.

January 3, 7, 10, 14, 17, 21, 24, 28, 31 **9:30 a.m.** **Sonoran Lifestyles** *1 Mile Guided Walk*
Join a park naturalist on this 2-hour, 1-mile walk to discover how plants and animals adapt to life in the desert. Wear comfortable walking shoes and bring

Join a naturalist for this 2-hour, 2-mile easy walk to discover the many fascinating facts about the Saguaro cactus.
