

# NATIONAL PARK REGULATIONS

Federal law protects all plants, animals, historic structures,  
and archeological sites.

Park is open daily from dawn to 11 p.m.  
Camping and overnight parking are prohibited.

Pets must be leashed and physically controlled at all times.

Vehicles, bicycles, and mopeds are allowed only on roads  
and in parking areas.

ONLY fruits, nuts, unoccupied seashells and mushrooms may be collected  
for personal use.

Removal or cutting of driftwood logs is prohibited.  
Firewood may be gathered and burned in park designated areas.

Digging or using metal detectors is prohibited.

Using or possessing fireworks is prohibited year-round.

Do not hunt, trap or use firearms on park lands.

Deposit all picnic refuse in trashcans. Disposal of household or commercial  
trash in park receptacles is prohibited.

Horseback riding is allowed by permit in designated areas only.
