World Environmental History)

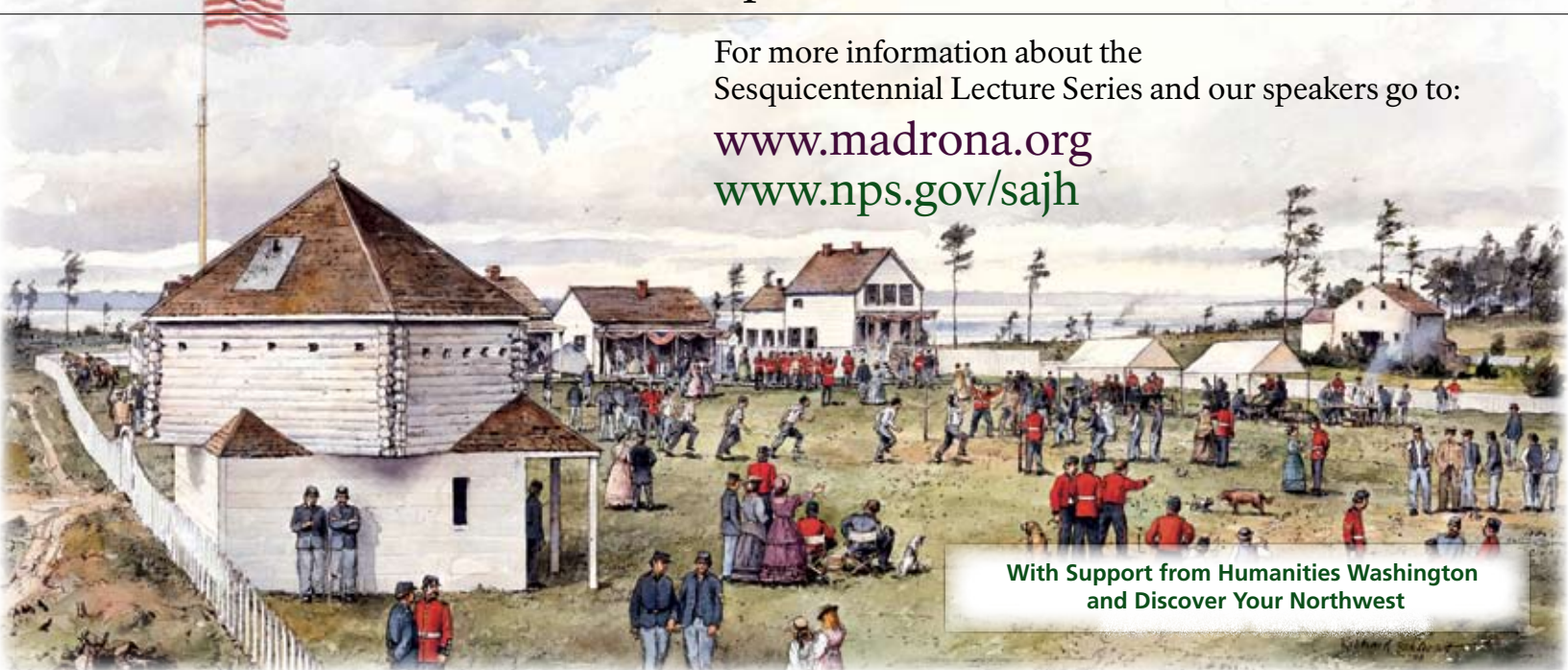
